

Confirmation

Confirmation Sunday here at Hope Lutheran is on Reformation Sunday, **October 26.** This year, four of our youth will be confirmed at the 9:00am worship service. Please keep Addison, Blake, Nolan, and Violet in your prayers as they prepare to take this important step in their faith journey.

Confirmation in the Lutheran Church is often referred to as Affirmation of Baptism. It is an opportunity for a person to affirm for themselves the promises that their parents, sponsors congregation made for them at their baptism: with them among God's faithful people, bring them to the word of God and the holy supper, teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in their hands the holy scriptures, and nurture them in faith and prayer, so that your children may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace." During the Affirmation of Baptism, those being confirmed profess their faith and their intention "to live among God's faithful people, to hear his Word and share in his Supper, to proclaim the Good News of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth."

Each year as I watch the youth of our church affirm their faith, I can't help but remember my own Confirmation service—feeling sweaty under my robe, nervousness over having to speak in public, my godfather's big hand pressing on my head during the blessing, the love and support of the church family behind me. It's also a time when I think about whether I have kept those promises made for me at baptism and affirmed at my own Confirmation. I encourage you to do the same as we gather together on October 26 to worship our Lord Jesus and support Addison, Blake, Nolan, and Violet.

GriefShare is a 13-week non-denominational, faith-based, grief support groups to help people deal with all the complex feelings after the death of a loved one. The lay people leading the classes have experienced grief themselves and have gone through special training. Each 90-minute session consists of a 10–15 minute checkin time, a 30-40 minute DVD presentation by experts in the field of grief, and 25-30 minutes to discuss the DVD topics. The Hope Lutheran Food Pantry serves those in need throughout Rusk County. Much of the food that is distributed through the food pantry comes from the Feed My People Food Bank. Volunteers are needed on Mondays, October 6 & 20 at 9:15am to help unload this delivery and stock food pantry shelves. Call Committee Update: The church profile will be submitted when the video is complete.

NALC Ratification Vote: Ratification of NALC constitutional changes will be done at the annual meeting in January. The congregation's vote needs to be submitted by February 8, 2026.

New Christian School Presentation: Bev Dukerschein requested time to present information including a video about their new school, Firm Foundation Academy. Council voted to approve the presentation at the October 12 worship service.

Lay Communion: Pastor Simonson offered to conduct lay communion training on September 21.

Property Committee: The buttons for the handicapped access are being addressed. Procuring quotes for sealing the parking lot. A dishwasher for the parsonage has been purchased and installed. Volunteers will be needed for fall maintenance.

Worship & Music: The pedals on the organ are not working well and may need to be addressed. Servicing of the audio-visual system may be needed.

Youth Ministry: Youth were invited to a movie night at Glen Flora Lutheran. Discussed Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child boxes. Pastor Hailey Halmstad is teaching confirmation for the two 7th graders.
