

SERVICE OF AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM

Pastor: These persons have been instructed in the Christian faith and desire to make public affirmation of their Baptism: Violet Alice Craker, Addison Ann Hulle, Nolan Randy Kammerud, Blake Charles Nyhagen.

Dear brothers and sisters, we rejoice that you now desire to make public profession of your faith and assume greater responsibility in the life of our Christian community and its mission in the world. In Holy Baptism our Lord Jesus Christ received you and made you members of his Church. In the community of God's people, through God's Word, you have learned his loving purpose for you and all creation. You have been nourished at God's holy table and called to be witnesses to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Now, therefore, I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we baptize.

Do you renounce all forces of evil, the devil, and all his empty promises?

Confirmands: I do.

P: Do you believe in God the Father?

Congregation: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth.

P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

C: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

- P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?
- C: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
- P: As young adults, you have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism?

to hear his Word and share in his Supper,

to proclaim the Good News of God in Christ through word and deed,

to serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus,

and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Confirmands: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me.

P: Let us pray.

Gracious Lord, through water and the Spirit you have made these young adults your own. You forgave them all their sins and brought them to newness of life. Continue to strengthen them with the Holy Spirit, and daily increase in them your gifts of grace: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence; through Jesus Christ, your Son, Our Lord.
